

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLETON

BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-063

Being a by-law to establish the fees and charges for various services provided by the municipality and repeal By-law Number 2012-047 and any amendments thereto and By-law Number 2015-060

WHEREAS Section 391. (1) of *The Municipal Act*, 2001 S.O. CHAPTER 25 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") permits a municipality and a local board to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 69 of *The Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that a Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to prescribe a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 7, *Building Code Act*, S.O. 1992, c25, as amended, provides that a Council a municipality may pass a by-law to prescribe fees for the processing of applications for permits or for the issuance of permits.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLETON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The fees and charges for various municipal services are established as shown in the Schedules attached hereto and forming part of this By-law;

2. The fees and charges as set forth in each schedule attached hereto, shall come into effect July 1, 2015.
3. All fees and charges are due and payable at the time the service is provided. If the fees or any portion thereof remain unpaid 30 days from the date of invoicing, interest at the rate of 1.25% shall be charged, and again on the first of each month thereafter until the account is paid in full.
4. All fees and charges are subject to applicable taxes where indicated on the schedules attached.
5. In the event that any particular provision or provisions or part of a provision in this by-law is found to be void, voidable or unenforceable for any reason whatever, then the particular provision or provisions or part of the particular provision shall be deemed severed from the remainder of this by-law and all other provisions shall remain in full force.
6. All charges payable under this by-law including taxes, interest and collection costs constitute a debt of the person or persons charged and if unpaid, where permissible, shall be added to the tax roll for any property

in the Township of Mapleton owned by such person or persons and may be collected in the same manner as taxes.

7. This by-law shall be known as the "Fees and Charges By-law"
8. By-law 2012-047 and any amendments thereto and 2015-060 are hereby repealed.

READ a first, second third time and finally passed this 23rd day of June, 2015.
